### **1. Fabric**

How are we using our building/s to enhance our mission?

### **2. Worship**

How does our ecumenical partnership contribute to the style, openness, accessibility, and joy of our worship?

### **3. Ministry**

How do we express and demonstrate our partnership in ministry among both ordained and lay members of the community of faith?

### **4. Community involvement**

How does our ecumenical partnership interact with the local community? For instance:

- helping the Christian community to reach out and become more effectively engaged in the lives of people round about, offering fullness of life;
- being involved in society and its redemption so that the community has a stake in what goes on in our LEP.

### **5. Young People**

How does our ecumenical partnership make the life of our church/es open to young people through programmes which involve and incorporate them? How is our Safeguarding Training carried out?

### **6. Communication**

How does our partnership ensure that people know what is going on in all parts of the LEP?

### **7. Finance**

How does our ecumenical partnership affect the finances of the local Christian community (including Denominational Returns)?
